





ABC Collaborative 2025 is a specially-tailored programme to promote mutual learning, cultural exchange and international understanding & bonding among students of ASEAN countries through a hackathon. The objectives of **ABC Collaborative 2025** are as follows:

Participants should also be proficient in English in both written and speech, proficient in using social media apps like Tiktok and Instagram, and proficient in using presentation tools like PowerPoint slides or equivalent.

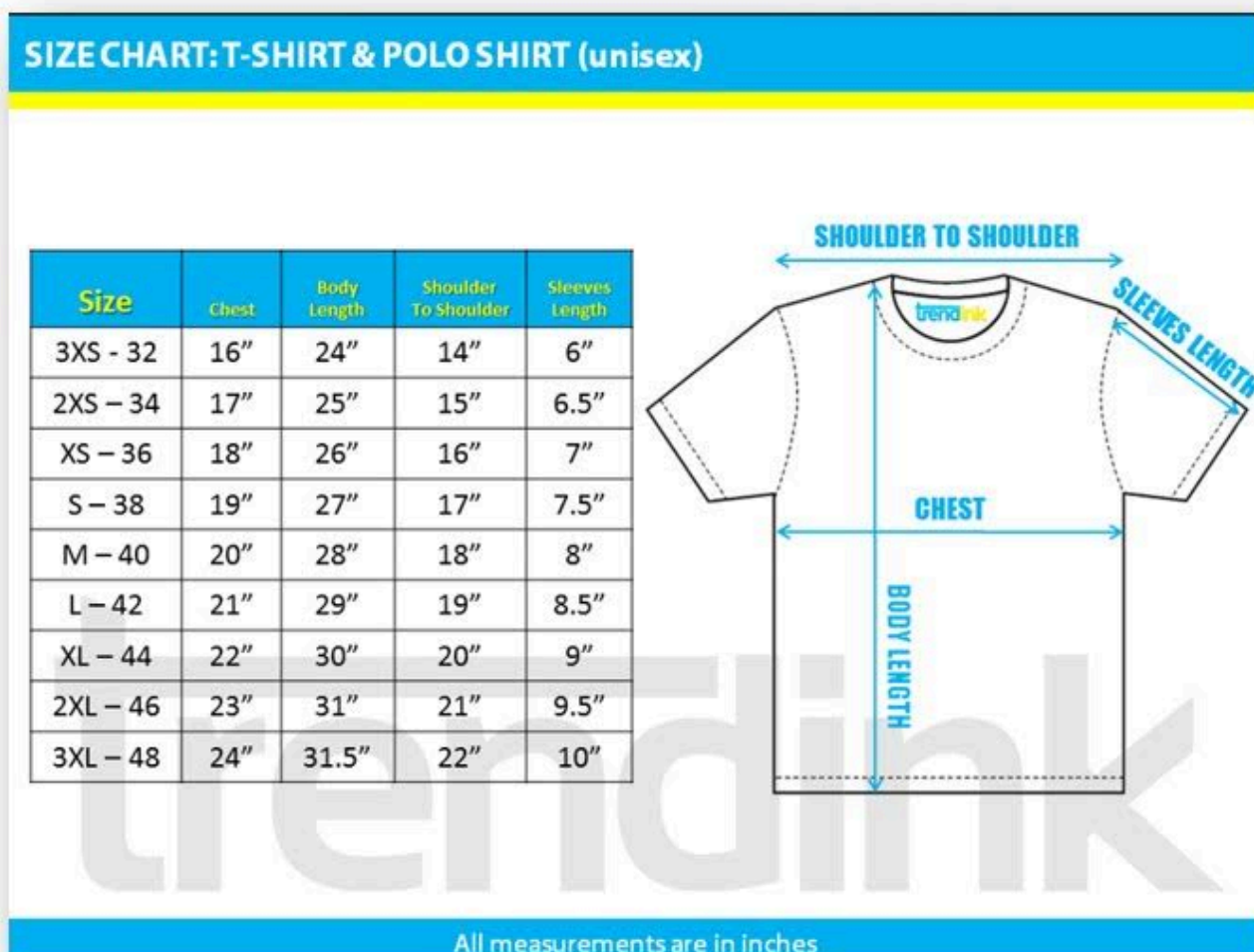
If any participant is not travelling with the main-body, he/she may take the following transport to the SP Staff Apartments
